DIVERSE ABILITIES

Founded in 1955 by Mrs Phyllis Edwards who formed a group of parents intent on providing better opportunities for their children with physical and learning disabilities.

Diverse Abilities has grown steadily since it was established in 1955 and we are proud to be able to boast of having supported hundreds of adults and children over the years.



BLANDFORD FOOD BANK

It is a sad reality that currently in the UK many families and individuals do not have enough money to buy essential food items. Having to choose between paying essential bills or eating, people's lives can be turned upside down overnight.



Redundancy, sickness, financial difficulties and low incomes are just some of the struggles people face in our community. Locally in Blandford there are families and individuals in this situation right now. Blandford Food Bank was set up to help those people going through a crisis; providing them with emergency food parcels, sources of support and a warm welcome. It isn't a privilege to have food, everyone has this basic need.

HOME-START NORTH DORSET

Home-Start North Dorset is an independent registered charity that supports struggling families living in the North Dorset District Council area and where there is at least one child under five.

Their team of trained, parent volunteers offer support, friendship and practical help to families with young children who are facing a period of difficulty. This enables them to cope better and provide a home environment that will give their children the best possible start in life.

Loneliness, relationship breakdown, bereavement, physical and mental illness or even multiple births can have a profound effect on families. Home-Start can be there to help them cope and to help them towards independence and a better future.
