

## **DRAFT Minutes of the Spetisbury Parish Council Meeting held at 7.45pm on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2022 in the Village Hall.**

### **Agenda:**

**22/77. To Receive Apologies:** CLLrs Adams, Cummings, Kerby (DC)

**22/78. Declaration of Interest and Grant of Dispensation:** None

**22/79. Open Forum:**

A question was raised about the broken dog waste bin – Clerk to chase Dorset Council.

Following the recent accident at Crawford Crossroads, it was raised that this is fast becoming an accident blackspot. The Give Way lines are indistinct, Clerk to contact Highways. Also a note is to be placed in Three Villages News asking residents to report accidents to the Clerk so that an anecdotal record can be maintained.

Village Hall wall - Cllr Woodford reported that the surveyor was happy with work carried out to date, the rendering is now complete. It was decided that the wall be painted a light grey. The scaffolding will have to stay until the painting is completed.

The Chairman reported on his meeting with the Headteacher, Several concerns were raised regarding volumes crossing the A350 and lack of footpath between the School car park and the A350. The Chairman is to monitor the number of families crossing the road as this seems to be increasing.

### **Items for Decision:**

**22/80. Minutes of the Meeting Monday 6<sup>th</sup> June 2022 were agreed and signed by Cllr Dunhill. Proposed Cllr Woodford, seconded Cllr Hall.**

**22/81. Land Adjacent to the Church – discuss Dorset Council’s Stance:** After discussion, it was agreed that although the Council have issues with this, no further action is to be taken.

**22/82. Parking Throughout the Village:** Complaints have been raised regarding inconsiderate parking in Priory Gardens and Abbey View. This is not the first time this has been raised as an issue but as both roads are under Highways jurisdiction, motorists are allowed to park providing they are not causing an obstruction. A note regarding considerate parking, including on pavements, is to be placed in the Three Villages News.

Discussion also took place regarding footpaths. It was asked that the Rights of Way Officer be asked to attend the September meeting.

**22/83. To Approve Financial Statement and list of payments and sign the same:** A copy of the accounting statement for June was displayed to Councillors and proposed by Cllr Bew, seconded by Cllr Hall, signed by Cllr Dunhill.

**22/84. Correspondence and Clerk’s report:** A list of emails circulated to Councillors was displayed.

Speedwatch – now only have 7 confirmed volunteers. Appeal to be placed in TVN.

Jubilee – the total spend of £926 was more or less equal to Charlton Marshall so no adjustment necessary.
